Sea otters live in the ocean and almost never come on land. When they sleep, a sea otter will wrap itself in kelp to make sure it doesn't float away.

They have large webbed feet that help them swim and waterproof fur to keep them warm. Often a sea otter will have a favorite rock that it will use to open hard shells like clams, crabs, or mussels.
