Protecting the Shoreline: A Shared Responsibility


December 10, 2025 from 7:00-8:30pm

This session will teach participants about coastal climate impacts, clam gardens as sites of cultural revitalization, and what individuals can do to promote shoreline health.

Participants will learn about the Green Shores® program, which was designed to help waterfront landholders restore natural shorelines using science-based tools and best practices to minimize the impacts of new development and view brand-new data from the shoreline hardening mapping initiative led by the Pacific Salmon Foundation.
